

Lob the Cob | Est 2010

Rules on how to play



Equipment

- 1 x Wooden Peel
- 1 x 400g White Cob (per player)
- 1 x Tape Measure

How to play

The rules of the game are simple. A throwing line is set up where players must remain behind at all times. Stepping over the line means the throw is forfeited. The cob is placed on the peel and is “Lobbed” as far as possible. Important to note that only the “Cob” is to be thrown. If the peel is released while the cob is in play the throw is forfeited. Player can run up or remain standing to “Lob the Cob.” The measurement is taken from where the “Cob” bounces and not where it rolls too. The winning player is the person who can “Lob the cob” the furthest.

How to Enter the Final at ABST Conference

Colleges and Universities should hold semi-finals prior to the conference and submit the names of the male and female champion from these semi finals to abst.contactus@gmail.com before the Wednesday prior to conference.

The final is held on the Saturday of Conference at 1pm outside the conference centre. The two champions from each college or university will play against the other champions in order to be crowned King and Queen of Lob the Cob, who will both receive £50.00 each in prize money and a “Lob the Cob” trophy to keep.

T&C's - 1. Students should ensure that when practising and holding semi finals, there is enough space to play the game, without risk of damaging property or causing injury to the player or spectators. 2. During the final, each champion is allowed only one throw each. 3. In the case of a tie, the players will throw again and the longest lob will decide the winner. 4. The judges decision is final on the day of the competition.
